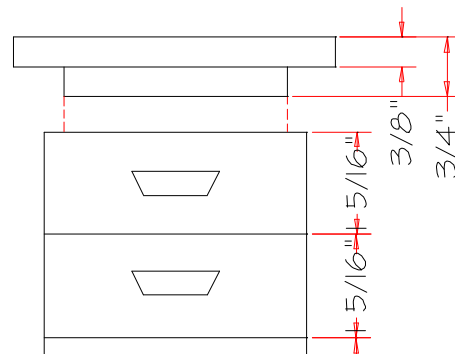

Required Tools:

This project can be built using only a table saw and a table-mounted router. An electric sander is also recommended. Router Bits required: 1/8" straight bit, 1/4" straight bit, 60/45 degree v-grooving bit Carbide bits are recommended for use with hard materials such as MDF. CAUTION: a dust mask is recommended when cutting and sanding MDF and other resin-based materials.
